According to the City's website, the sealing crews have begun working on Bedford Road and will work from east to west, starting at Highway 157. The crew will start by routing the cracks in the street and, after the sealing materials arrive, they'll return to Harwood Road to complete the work at that location before completing work on Bedford Road. Once Harwood, Bedford, Cummings, Hospital Parkway, L. Don Dodson, Martin, McLain, Schumac and Shady Brook are complete, the crew will seal streets in residential neighborhoods.

This program is paid by the ½-cent sales tax that is put into the 4-B Street Maintenance Fund. For information on the Street Crack Sealing Program, contact the Public Works Department at 817/952-2200.
